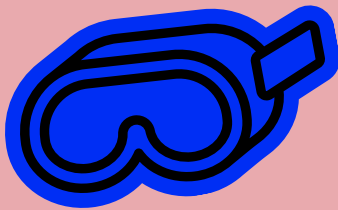

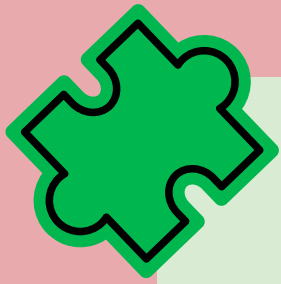
# What We Offer

## Club Categories

The clubs coloured **GREEN** are clubs that are run internally by our staff. Some of these clubs have limited spaces and some unlimited.

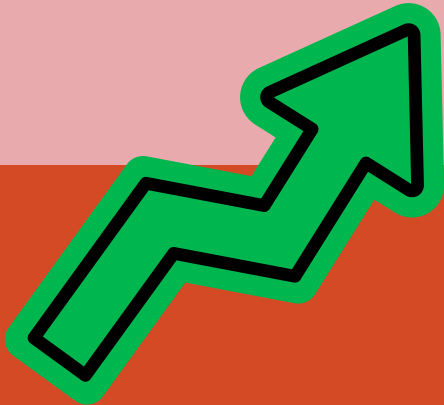
The clubs coloured **ORANGE** are clubs provided by external organisations. You can book your daughter on to these by contacting the clubs directly, all contact information is provided on the flyers attached to this School Post and can also be found on Firefly in the co-curricular section. The external provider will confirm your daughter's place and collect payment directly from you.

The clubs coloured **YELLOW** are invitational clubs and your daughter will be selected to join these either by invite, trial or audition. You will be contacted directly if your daughter has been successful in obtaining a place.



## How to Register for Internal Green Clubs

We will publish the names of girls attending each club on Firefly on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November. Please read the information on page 5&6 to help you apply.



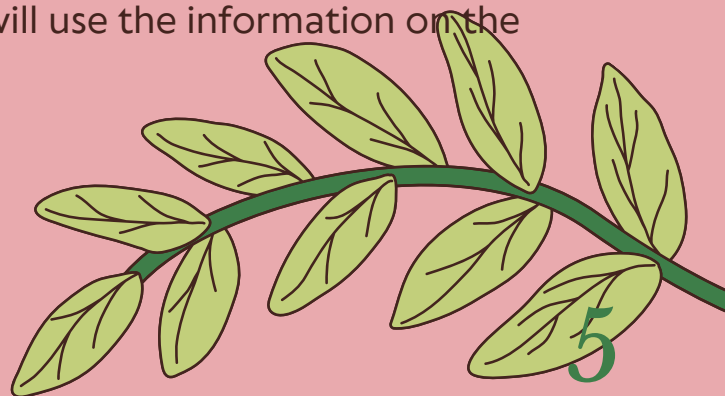
There is no advantage to completing this form early as clubs will only be allocated after the deadline, so please take your time to consider, with your daughter, which clubs she would really like to attend.





## **What to remember when registering for Internally run Green Clubs that are *limited by spaces***

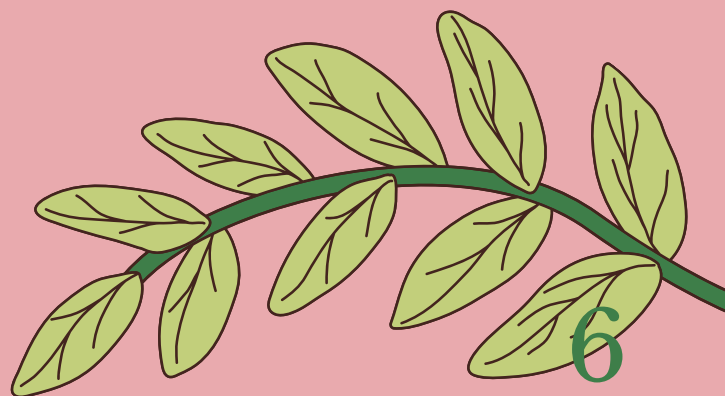
- Enter the details of your daughter. If you have more than one daughter at the school, please complete a separate application for each. Please ensure that the email address you enter is the one you would like us to use to contact you regarding clubs.
- Please select up to a maximum of 4 clubs by selecting your daughter's 1st choice from the list of options available, and then if you want to, a 2nd, 3rd and 4th choice. Please be aware that if any of the choices are on the same day, your daughter will only be able to be allocated one of them.
- When the forms are processed, we will aim to allocate every girl their first-choice club. However, if a club is oversubscribed, those girls who do not have a place will be allocated their second-choice club and, if that is full, their third and so on. If you only sign your daughter up for one club preference and it is over-subscribed, she will not be allocated an alternative. Please note that she will be allocated no more than 3 clubs unless there are spaces available in her 4th choice club.
- Please be aware that it may not be possible to allocate clubs on the same day for siblings or to put siblings or friends in the same club.
- If your daughter was given a place in ART club for the Autumn term, she will not be able to sign up for ART in the Spring or Summer terms, this is due to its popularity.
- In the event of a club attracting insufficient interest to be viable, it may be cancelled, and any girls affected will be invited to choose an alternative.
- If you realise that you have made a mistake after submitting the form, complete another one and we will use the information on the last form submitted.





## What to remember when registering for Internally run Green Clubs that are *unlimited by spaces*

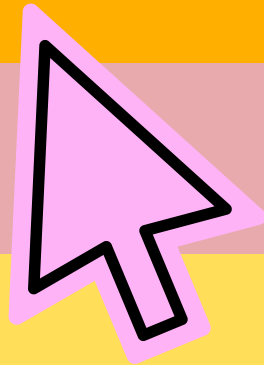

## How to Register for External/Orange Clubs



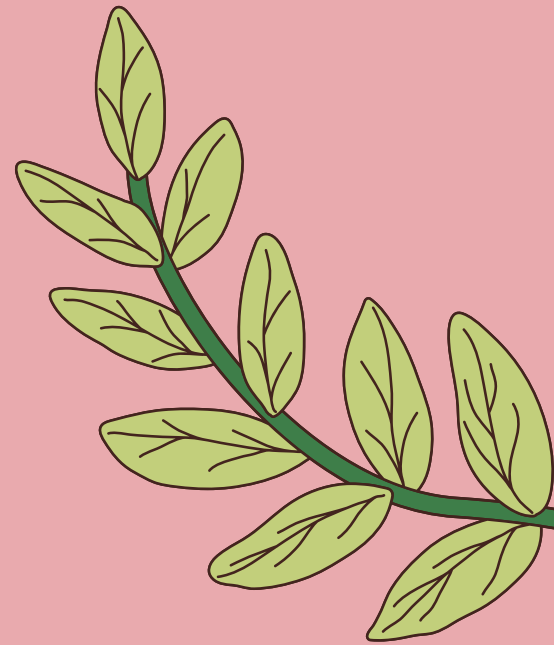

These clubs are invitational only and you will be contacted directly if your daughter has been selected to join.

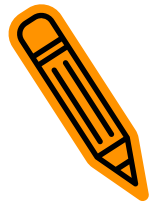

# Music Clubs Glossary

## **ABRSM Aural Class**

This is a drop-in class to prepare for the aural aspect of ABRSM music exams. The girls will be taught the appropriate language to use and how best to answer the questions. Ear tests and pitching will be covered too.

Merel Van Der Knoop and Mr. Wray will be leading these sessions.

Grade 1-3 = Friday 12:30 – 1.00pm Friday

Grade 4+ = Thursday 10:00 - 10:25am

## **Vox Chamber Choir (Y5&Y6)**

The Vox Chamber Choir is the Junior School's flagship choir for Year 5 and Year 6 pupils and is auditioned annually and divided into 3 or sometimes 4 parts.

The choir performs at whole school events and concerts, as well as taking part in competitions and tours.

## **Chamber Ensemble (Gr 5+)**

Mr. Wray will be inviting instrumentalists of Grade 5+ to work together on chamber ensemble skills and collaborative music making.

This is a great opportunity for our more advanced instrumentalists to play together.

## **Chamber String Ensemble (Gr4+)**

The String Chamber Ensemble is for advanced string players of at least Grade 4 level.

The girls are expected to audition by our string specialist, Ms. Ward, before being offered a place.

## **Orchestra (Gr2+)**

All pupils that play an orchestral instrument above Grade 2 are expected to join the orchestra.

Girls may join at the start of each term in consultation with Mr. Wray.

There is no audition, but girls should confirm their attendance with Mr. Wray or Dr. Belton first before attending. The orchestra performs termly in our concerts, and they play a variety of music from classical to popular hits too.

## **Flute Ensemble (Gr1+)**

All flautists Grade 1 plus are welcome to attend this group. We work on 3- and 4-part flute ensemble music.

Often the musical arrangements are created bespoke to match the players' level.

Dr. Belton will be leading this group.

## **Guitar Ensemble (Gr1+)**

All guitarists Grade 1 and above are welcome to attend this ensemble.

Mr. Howell creates bespoke arrangements of a variety of different genres and girls may play picked guitar or chords in this ensemble.

## **HIT IT! Percussion Ensemble**

As the name suggests, this group is all about making music by hitting it.

The group play djembe drums and will also explore Samba music with our Samba Band kit.

No previous experience is necessary, just a good sense of pulse and enthusiasm to make a band together.

The group is led by Mr. Hiscock, our drum kit teacher.

## **Koro Chamber Choir (Y3&Y4)**

The Koro Chamber Choir is an auditioned choir for Year 3 and Year 4 pupils.

They will learn more advanced music than in the Year 3 and Year 4 curriculum chorus lessons and look at vocal technique, notation reading and singing in parts.

This choir is led by Mr. Wray.

## **Music Theatre Group (Y5&Y6)**

This group is open to all girls in Year 5 and Year 6. The girls will work on vocal harmonies, vocal projection and technique, in accompanied and a cappella arrangements of songs.

They will explore stage craft and choreography to present a selection of musical theatre numbers for a showcase each term.

This group will be led musically by Mr. Wray.





# Music Clubs Glossary

## **Lower Junior Choir (Y1&Y2)**

The emphasis on this choir is fun and singing with expression. The girls sing songs that tell a story, and they are encouraged to be as expressive as possible. All girls in Year 1 and Year 2 are welcome to join. This choir is led by Mr. Wray.

## **Mini Drummers (Y1&Y2)**

Open to all students in Y1 and Y2. Come and explore creating a percussion group and playing a range of untuned percussion. The girls will explore a variety of instruments and notation styles. Mini Drummers is led by Mr. Wray.

## **Mini Orchestra (Y1&Y2)**

All students in Year 1 and Year 2 are welcome to attend the mini orchestra group. The girls explore different tuned and un-tuned percussion and create pieces with different parts to perform in our termly concerts. All instrumentalists are encouraged to attend, learning skills to prepare for playing in another ensemble. Mini Orchestra is led by Dr. Belton.

## **Chamber String Ensemble (Gr4+)**

The String Chamber Ensemble is for advanced string players of at least Grade 4 level. The girls are expected to audition with our string specialist, Ms. Ward, before being offered a place.

## **String Ensemble (Gr3 and below)**

String players who have had at least two terms learning their instrument up to Grade 3 are welcome to join the String Ensemble. The group enjoys working on ensemble skills together, as well general string technique.

## **Ukulele Club**

This group is a beginner club. Learn to play your favourite pop songs after learning the chord shapes and strumming patterns. No previous experience is necessary, and ukuleles and picks are provided, although girls are welcome to bring their own instrument.

## **Wind Band (Gr2+)**

The wind band is a flexible ensemble and all woodwind, brass and percussion students of Grade 2 and above are expected to attend. The ensemble plays pop songs, jazz and popular classics and often invite a singer to join them in concerts too.

## **Singing Games (Y3&Y4)**

Dr. Belton will be leading a fun singing group for Year 3 and Year 4 girls learning fun singing games and movement. This will run in conjunction with our partnership with Merton Music Foundation and their Singing Ambassadors Scheme.
