LAMDA Speech and Drama club started at Wimbledon High School in 2017 and the girls achieve fantastic exam results each year. The course is run by Helen Goodman, owner and director of Theatre on the River Ltd which provides LAMDA and Drama courses across schools in London.

We run the course during lunch breaks:

- Monday Year 7 and 8 LAMDA: 1.00-1.40 Year 9 -13 LAMDA: 1.40-2.20pm
- Wednesday Year 7 and 8 LAMDA: 1.00-1.40, Year 9 – 13 LAMDA: 1.40-2.20pm

The course runs for 10 weeks per term and costs £160 per term. The LAMDA exams are taken at the LAMDA Drama school in Hammersmith, in May. Girls who sign up each September automatically roll forward each term, unless half a term's notice cancellation period is given. The exams take place at the LAMDA Drama School in Hammersmith over two weekends at the end of June. **Sign-ups are via the school SOCs site.**

LAMDA is an enormously beneficial and enjoyable club for children in Year 1 up to Year 13 in Senior Schools. LAMDA stands for The London Academic of Music and Dramatic Art and is a leading Drama School in Hammersmith, London.
